All are welcome - grades 4-8; no experience necessary. Come check it out to see if you are interested in joining one of our Harvard teams! Registration forms will be available from both Spectrum and First Lego League so that parents can sign their kids up while kids participate.

If the challenge set comes in by then and we can get some CORI checked parent volunteers to supervise building of the set with any kids who want to stay, we will extend the time until 2pm. Here is a summary of the options currently available:

## First Lego League - Recreational Team Space is limited!

Meets once a week (Wednesdays) and competes in an in house tournament with other HES and perhaps other local teams looking for a "scrimmage." (Made up of students in grades 4-8 with no experience or who have experience but who want a less rigorous experience.) Program runs from September (start date TBD)- until the in house competition in November.

## First Lego League - Competitive Team Grades 5-8 with Prior FLL experience

**Space is limited**, if needed, a second team may be added

More serious group of programmers, builders, problem solvers and creators who meet once a week go to the official competition at WPI (Likely to meet more often in the week or two before the competition). Made up of students in grade 5 and above with previous FLL experience. The competition team will meet on **Fridays after school**. Program runs from September - the tournament in December.

FEE: \$300
