

Summer Adventure Information



for students entering Grades K - 6 Fall 2017

Come have some great summer fun right here at Hildreth Elementary! We use HES Room 151, gym, staff lounge and cafeteria as well as the playground and HES ball field, the Town Beach (If you choose to have your child participate in swim lessons at the pond we will register them and take the children to lessons while they are with our program). Optional Tennis lessons with Marcus Lewis Tennis Extension program also available. Our Summer Adventure Staff: Lisa Robichaud, Andy Sawyer, Alexa Cavanaugh and Janet Woodsum. Our support staff are high school student and CIT helpers (minimum grade 7 & up). We will be in small groups with lots of fun activities: We all walk to the pond for Morning swim (playing on the beach for those not taking lessons) Students taking tennis (optional) walk to Bromfield with a staff member or CIT, Project of the Day, games, nature, art & drama, free swim or beach playtime at the end of the day. Our drama performance is on July 14. We'll provide a tasty, cool afternoon snack. Students bring their own lunch each day.

Our drama this year will be stories and poems from "Where the Sidewalk Ends" by Shel Silverstein, and other Shel Silverstein books (One of Andy's favorites!) Performance for parents and friends on Friday, July 14 (No After-Program care on July 14/Performance day)

Week 4 July 17-21, Creative Campers! Design and Create a "camper" or tiny house, or choose to create your very own SuperHero/Comic Book Character, be a Costume Designer and design the outfit of your dreams, use items like duct tape, paper plates, aluminum foil....almost anything! Be creative!

Week 5 July 25-29, Science Fun - Science project fun! Also, a field trip or special presentation this week!

Program hours are 8:30 a.m.-4:00 p.m. Children may be dropped off after 8:00 a.m.

After Program care is available from 4:00 p.m.-6:00 p.m. for an additional fee (see registration form).

Date of Note: Friday, July 14th is the date for the Summer Adventure Theater Performance. Children will perform the story "Where the Sidewalk Ends" by Shel Silverstein for parents and friends. They create the sets, help with costumes, work "back-stage" and memorize their lines. It's amazing to see what they can do in a short time! No after program care is available on this day, July 14.

Tuition balance is due by **June 1.** All forms, including current physical (*within 13 months of program dates*) and Emergency form are due in the Community Education office by **June 1st**.

Swimming lesson option: Lessons are offered through Harvard Park & Rec, cost: \$40/child per session. If you wish to have your child take swim lessons, we will register them (all Summer Adventure students take lessons at the same time). Swim Sessions are 2 weeks in length, this year starting on Friday, June 30 –July 14 (no July 4) and July 17-28. We will take your child to lessons while they are attending Summer Adventure. If your child only attends Summer Adventure during 1 of the weeks of swim lessons, it is the parent's responsibility to take the child to lessons during the other week. Lessons for Summer Adventure participants start at 9/9:30 a.m. We register for swim lessons in advance, slots are limited, please be sure to get your Summer Adventure registration in early!

OR (May choose either Swimming or Tennis, scheduling does not allow to do both)



Tennis lesson option: Tennis lessons are taught on the courts at The Bromfield School by the Marcus Lewis Tennis Extension Program. If you are interested in having your child participate in tennis lessons while they are attending Summer Adventure, our staff will walk them to and from lessons.

*Students with 8:15 a.m. lessons are dropped off by parent at the tennis courts (behind Bromfield). Summer Adventure staff will meet them at 9 a.m. to bring them back to HES. Students with 9 a.m. lessons may be brought to lessons by parents or dropped off

Enrollment is open to Harvard Residents and School Choice students attending HES. Students must be entering grades K-6 in the Fall of 2017. Space is limited and filled on a first-come first-served basis.
