

CURRICULUM DEVELOPMENT AND ADOPTION

Constant adaptation and development of the curriculum is necessary if the District is to meet the needs of the students in its schools. To be successful, curriculum development must be a collaborative enterprise involving staff and administrators utilizing their professional expertise.

The Committee expects its faculty and administration to regularly evaluate the education program and to recommended modifications of practice and changes in curriculum content as well as the addition or deletion of courses to the instructional program. (Taken from MASC policy)

The Superintendent will report to the School Committee periodically as to the status of the district's curriculum. S/he will assess and evaluate the status of the curriculum with respect to current national standards, student performance, and current educational research and trends. S/he will identify and prioritize where revisions and changes are needed and identify the resources needed to enact and support those changes. Curriculum reviews and revisions will include the review of curriculum in light of the appropriate national standards, Common Core Standard, state curriculum frameworks and research in the field.
